Thank you for your interest in hosting the Second Annual National Judging Symposium, to be held on the third weekend in August (or as close to that date as possible) somewhere on the East coast.

I have finally received a financial report from the hosts of the First Symposium, which is attached to this letter. Please bear in mind that the budget was experimental, since it was our first National undertaking, and we are open to suggestions from the host.

In general, the outline of the Symposium should include a video-taped competition and facilities for an extensive analytical-type playback the next day, classroom sessions on rules, technical sessions (with demonstrators) on various aspects of the skills of gymnastics, small meeting rooms for various interest groups, two general meetings (opening and closing sessions), plus a banquet or some other type of social gathering. Any additional ideas of your own choosing would be most welcome.

Since the attendance last year topped 150, regardless of the two Elite clinics the next weekend, we definitely expect over 200 judges to attend the second symposium. Depending on the location, it might be even larger. The duration should be from Friday noon to Sunday noon, with some smaller groups wishing to meet before or after the official opening and closing sessions. Any net profit (after all expenses) will be evenly shared between the host organization and NAWGJ.

If you are sincerely interested in hosting the 1977 Symposium, please submit a letter with the following information:

- a) description of the site, its location and accessibility
- b) general organizational outline (how are you going to organize it)
- c) suggestions for sessions and other activities
- d) proposed budget
- e) registration fee necessary

Please submit this information to me by Feb. 15th, at which time the selection will be made and all bidders notified as soon as possible thereafter.
